



This is your step-by-step guide to uploading/changing the banner behind your profile picture:


- Click the Me icon at the top of your LinkedIn homepage
- Click View profile
- Click the Pencil icon in the upper right of your introduction section
- Click the option that applies: Upload photo or Change photo
- Select the Proud to be a Registered Interpreter LinkedIn Banner JPEG from your computer, and click Open
- Click Apply
- The image will upload automatically

Note, there is no need to resize or adjust the image.





A4 Infosheets



You will find an A4 infosheet listing your key credentials as an RPSI that you can print out and give to your prospective clients – such as you're the nearest courts to your home, local GP surgeries, solicitors, police stations and Citizens Advice Bureaux.

There are two versions of this PDF document, see next slide.

One includes a contact form that you can complete with your contact information.

You can type into the form fields before printing the document or print it out before completing it by hand.

The other version doesn't include the contact form.

You might prefer to print this version and attach a business card instead.

The infosheet is designed for home printing.

You can also choose to print it in greyscale (black and white) to save on ink.


