- You must be a British or European Citizen or have indefinite leave to remain in the U.K. You must have been a permanent resident in the U.K for last 3 years.

QUALIFICATIONS

You must hold **one** of the following.

- Full member of the National Register of Public Services Interpreters
- Diploma in Public Service Interpreting (Law) or a letter of Credit in all Oral Components (Law)
- TQUK in Public Service Interpreting (RQF) Level 6
- IOL Diploma in Police Interpreting (DPI) Level 6
- Full assessment by the Asylum & Immigration Tribunal
- Full assessment by Metropolitan Police
